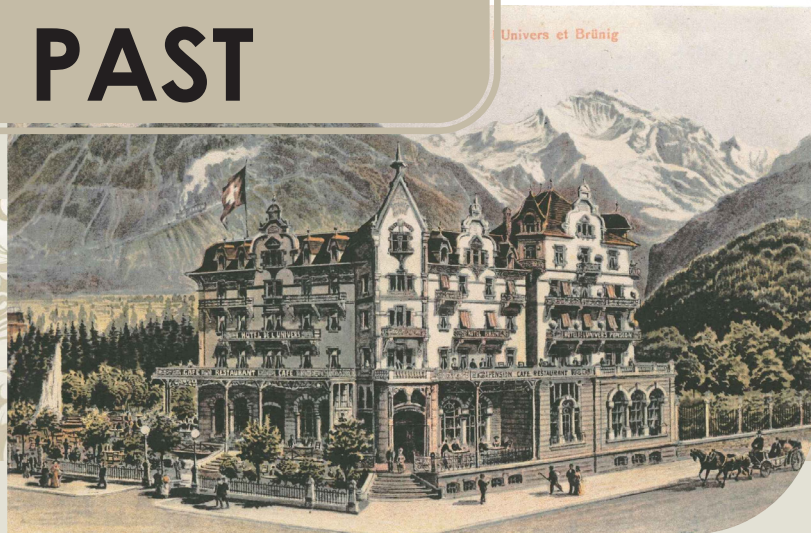

CARLTON - 1900

The Carlton was built as «Hotel Brüning et l'Univers» by Christian Hansen. The hotel had a large garden area with vegetable growings and a variety of trees. It even had a carriage service as well as a barn, located south of the hotel. The hotel was open from April to October and was regarded back then as very modern with private bathrooms, heaters and an elevator. It was owned together with the «Hotel Du Lac» by the Walter Hofmann family.

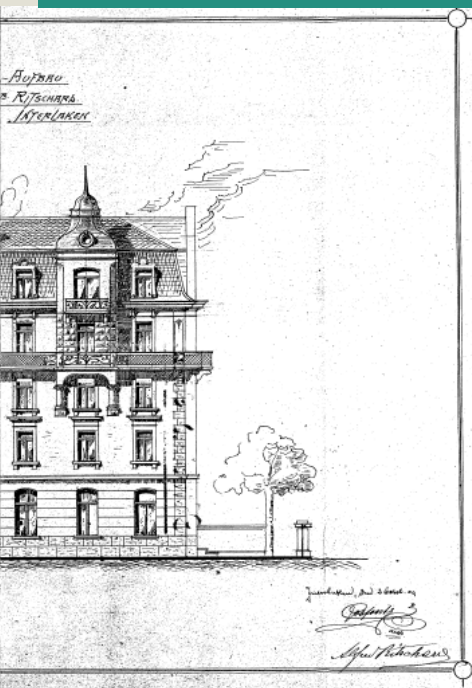

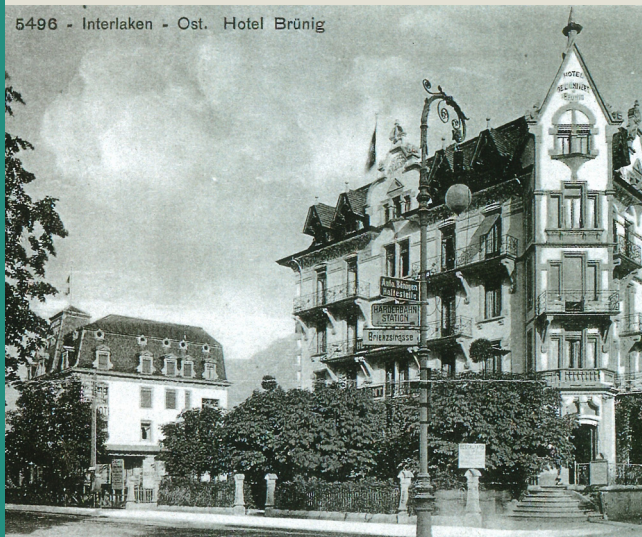
HOTEL DE L'EUROPE

Both buildings were built under the ownership of Karl Alfred Ritschard, a former official in Muri. Alice Ritschard, previous hotel secretary in Lugano managed the hotel. She had shared her duty with Gertrud Biert, born Ritschard, who was hotel manager in Chamby, Montreux. Therefor «Hotel de l'Europe» belonged until 1924 to the Ritschard family. Are they related to today's wine vendor Ritschard? The investigations are ongoing...

If we go through an old brochure of Alfred Ritschard, he praised his hotel with the following words:

«The Hotel de l'Europe is located in immediate walking distance to the train station Interlaken Ost, with a direct connection to Lauterbrunnen, Grindelwald-Wengernalp-Jungfrau and Schynige Plattebahn as well as to Lake Brienz boat pier and the Harder funicular railway. The hotel stands completely free on all sides...

EUROPE - 1931

Only seven years after the acquisition of the Hotel Europe, Ernst Kuchen passed away in August 1931. According to the assignment agreement between the widow Wilhelmina Kuchen and their son, Alfred Kuchen-Häberli, the hotel was passed on to him and his wife Hedwig Kuchen-Häberli the year after. She was the daughter of Erwin Häberli, host of «Gaststätte zum Schützenhaus» in Münchenbuchsee. The kitchen equipment was renewed and the coal stove was converted to a gas stove.

Second World War - 1939

Immediately after the outbreak on September 1st, the «Hotel Europe» was used as a military medical facility and served as admission location for wounded soldiers. Until the end of 1945 the hotel served as an army dental clinic. During the whole war only soldiers and no hotel guests were accommodated.

For the reopening after the end of the war, the hotel was in need of a profound renovation. Part of these costs were covered by the government.

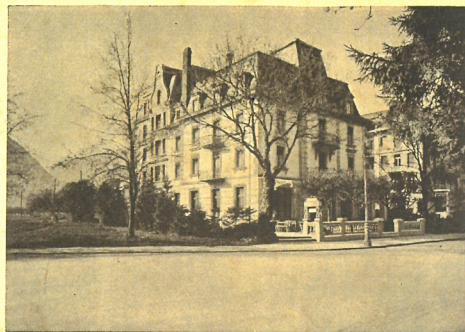

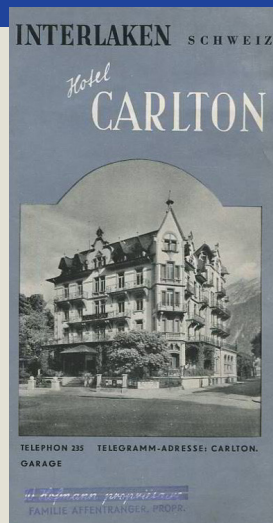

EUROPE - 1960

In January Hedwig & Alfred Kuchen-Häberli passed on the hotel to their son Roland Kuchen-Loder and his wife Elisabeth. Those two managed the hotel until 1981.

Elisabeth Kuchen remembered later: «In the 57 years, in which the Hotel was owned by our family, not just thousands of guests from all over the world, but also military and trainees went in and out».

EUROPE, GREAT REDEVELOPMENT - 1966

The roof and the front were completely renovated. The old wash house, where they still washed by hand, was set up as a modern laundry room with washing machines, dryer and a mangle. Additionally, the house was expanded with another dining room, today's „Salle de la Gare“. At the same time the «Hotel Europe» was established as a school hotel for the Swiss hotelier association.

The couple Roland and Elisabeth Kuchen-Loder conducted from 1966 until 1978 in the off season, meaning five weeks in spring and five weeks in autumn, hotel courses for the Swiss Hotelier Association. In each semester, around 70 women were trained by professional teachers. In addition the „Europe“ hosted apprenticeship exams for chefs, hotel assistants as well as service staff members. The hotel was owned by the Kuchen family for more than three generations, which gave the Europe its reputation. This way it established itself in the eastern neighbourhood as a renowned venue in Interlaken. At the regular's table many different subjects were discussed, such as the local life, community politics and school itself. Even hunters and alpinists met here.

In April, Yvette & Rudolf Schwab-Spycher bought the hotel. They previously owned the «Hotel Acacias» in Geneva. The family remained as owners until 1989.

VERSTEIGERUNG IN INTERLAKEN

Schweizer Bank übernimmt Hotel Europe



Das Hotel Europe wurde gestern vom Schweizer Bankkriesen UBS versteigert.

Für eine Million Franken übernahm gestern an der Versteigerung die UBS das Hotel Europe. Damit sind die Preisvorstellungen definiert, welche die Bank in Bezug auf das Jugendstil-Haus hat.

Der Verputz blättert ab, ein mit Silberfolie isoliertes Rohr schlägt sich über die Südfassade. Trotzdem: Das 1888 erbaute Hotel «Europe» mit seinen filigranen Balkongittern und dem ovalen Dachreiter im verschindelten Giebel auf der Südseite hat etwas vom Jugendstilcharme ins 21. Jahrhundert hinführgeliefert. Seinen letzten Besitzern, der Hotel Europe AG Interlaken mit Verwaltungsratspräsidentin Francesca Comte, hat dieser Charme kein Glück gebracht. 1995 haben sie das «Europe» gekauft, weil gestern Nacht um sieben Uhr vor dem Nichts. Das Hotel mit den 38 Zimmern, die teilweise saniert wurden, wurde versteigert. Ein wichtiger Grund für das Scheitern sei, dass die Bank einen ho-

wiligen Baukredit wieder zurückgezogen habe, sagt Francesca Comte.
Die UBS, die ging aus den Steigerungsbedingungen hervor, hat allerdings einiges investiert: Ihre Forderungen betragen 2,7 Millionen Franken. Die Gesamtbelastung des Betriebs belief sich auf 3,4 Millionen Franken. Die Schweizerische Gesellschaft für Hotelkredite hatte das «Europe» mit 600'000 Franken unterstützt und besitzt jetzt einen wertlosen Schuldbrief.

Verdecktes Interesse

Geleitet wurde die Versteigerung von Anna Sieber, und der Saal im Hotel Du Nord war gut besetzt. Anwesend waren einheimische Hoteliers und Geschäftsleute. Das Mindestangebot, mit dem die Steigerung begann, war Fr. 28'993.50, so viel betragen Verwertungskosten und gesetzliche Pfandrechte. Als Weibel Werner Thöni zum Angebot aufrief, blieb alles still. Die Regeln sind bekannt: Es hat keinen Sinn, ein Angebot zu machen, bis die Bank ihre Preisvorstellung über ein eigenes Angebot formuliert hat. Für die UBS Basel und Zürich tat dies Architekt Herbert Klossner aus Phönizien.

Sein Gebot von Franken blieb als so viel scheitern. Das Haus zahlte nach Auskunft einen sehr grossen Bedarf hat oder gar werden sollte.

Bank nicht mehr
Für den UBS Rudolf Bärli in der Versteigerung schenken. Er erklärte, resistenten gebe, nicht öffentlich in der Versteigerung auftreten. Bank auch später vorstellungen bläfen. Sicher ist, nicht «Europe» laut dem Interlaken der Werner Affentranger.
«Europe» in der sollte als touristisch weitergeführt werden.

THE END? - 1995

Francesca Comte acquired the Europe. She renovated the northern part of the hotel as well as the restaurant towards the Höhweg. Unfortunately, the economic success was not sufficient enough to continue with further necessary renovations and most of all, to fulfill the building safety guidelines of the canton of Berne. So was the former Europe AG imposed as bankrupt and the hotel was auctioned. As a result of the auction, the hotel went into possession of the UBS. Even after the great investments in the years 1995 - 1997, it was still in desperate need of renovations and further investment. It was even discussed, if the aged nouveau art building with its crumbly front ought to be torn down.

BERNENSIS HOTEL AG - 2001

Stephan JJ. Maeder managed, together with his colleague Till Klammer, to find enough acquaintances and friends to found the Bernensis Hotel AG. This new initiated joint stock company was able to acquire the hotel from the UBS and was ready, through charity work and the waiving of dividend payments to recover the hotel. With this strategy they managed to save it economical wise and were eager to continue the over one hundred year old history with lots of enthusiasm. In the first phase after 2001 the security and fire safety of the hotel were improved. According to the historic preservation guidelines, the whole front got refurbished as well as the rest of the rooms. Additionally the meeting room «Top of Europe» was built below the roof, to connect and continue the long term tradition of business through out the whole year. This way an attractive offer can be provided also during the low seasons. Already from the beginning it was decided, to lease the restaurants. The ladies Astrid Flück and Christine Steiner were hosts in their restaurant «Spontan», before it reopened under the name «Suppentopf». Through the years tenants and concepts changed, turning the «Spontan» to the beloved «Vinothek Wineart» and the «Suppentopf» into the restaurant «Shaliman».

On January 3rd the Bernensis Hotel AG took over «Hotel Carlton». In the meantime, both buildings were connected with a new lobby. All restaurants and hotel rooms were renovated, part of the front was built back into its original state, the balcony railing reconstructed and all the red panelling of the front were removed. Out of the previous laundry room became the meeting room «Harden», the office of the management became the fumoir, the parking spaces were extended, the gourmet restaurant «Chez-Pierre» received a new kitchen and the underground heating oil tank gave space for toilet facilities for «Johnny's» guests. The removal of the former laundry and the hotel kitchen offered space for the «Oberländer Wellnessdörfli» together with a hair saloon, a massage studio as well as a cosmetic and nail studio.

THE NEW CONSTRUCTION «ANNEX» - 2012/13

The vision becomes reality: The construction began in autumn. On the south side of the hotel a new building with a spacious garage, a new and large dining room with kitchen on the ground floor and a couple of apartments were planned. The parking garage was already finished in winter and started to be used in spring 2013. During the summer months no further renovations or constructions were done, so the guests would not be disturbed and could enjoy a relaxed stay.

INTERLAKEN Auf der Südseite des Hotels Carlton-Europe in Interlaken sind seit einiger Zeit Bauarbeiten im Gange. Vom Höheweg aus fast unsichtbar entsteht ein völlig neuer Trakt der beiden altherwürdigen Hotels, die seit 2005 zusammengehören. Hotelier Stephan JJ Maeder beabsichtigt, insgesamt rund 3 Millionen Franken in die Weiterentwicklung seines Hauses zu investieren. In der ersten Etappe steht jetzt die Realisation einer Einstellhalle an sowie im Erdgeschoss ein grosser neuer Eingangsbereich mit Lounge und Hotelbar. Sofern es die Geschäftslage erlaubt, will Maeder im Herbst 2013 mit der zweiten Bauetappe beginnen. Sie beinhaltet eine neue Hotelküche und einen Speisesaal gegen Süden sowie 15 Suiten. Gleichzeitig werden die Voraussetzungen erstellt für ein technisches Update, beispielsweise der Anschluss ans Fernwärme-Netz der Avari.

Studios in Mischnutzung

Ausschlaggebend für den Umbau waren mehrere Faktoren. Einerseits störte sich Maeder an der wenig schönen Umgebung auf der Südseite der Hotelanlage. «An prominenter Lage hatten wir die Parkplätze», sagt er. Andererseits wollten an der Fassade

SECOND STAGE- 2014

For autumn and winter 2013 further work was scheduled. Within a few months the new building behind the connecting wing was built. Our dining and seminar room Hansen-Ritschard-Saal (as homage to the builders Christian Hansen & Karl Alfred Ritschard) as well as the Salon Elisabeth, a room next door, were inaugurated in the middle of October. Regardless the usage as a meeting room or dining hall for corporate events or banquets, the Hansen-Ritschard-Saal offers space for 180 guests. Furthermore, it is flooded with day light, thanks to the huge windows around the hall, which reach from the top to the bottom. The direct access to the hotel garden is a highlight. A large fireplace creates a cosy ambience in the dining hall.
